MAIN HALL – Without Bar (kitchen usage is included in full evening event rental)	\$225.00 *If booking hall for a wedding there is the option of holding their stag & doe – rent free on a Friday evening (as available)– client would be responsible for cleaning - \$50.00 cleaning deposit or Rec. Committee will clean for \$75.00)
FRIDAY NIGHT RENTALS WITH BAR (Kitchen included)	\$75.00
#_____Bottles of Wine @\$3.00/bottle corkage fee	\$
MAIN HALL full day event (8 hrs) ending 5:00 p.m.	\$125.00 + \$50.00 cleaning deposit (or Rec. Committee will clean for \$75.00)
MAIN HALL 1/2 day (4 hrs)	50.00 + \$50.00 cleaning deposit (or Rec. Committee will clean for \$75.00)
DECORATING (other than day of rental, to secure hall for decorating) (decorations to be removed immediately after event)	\$50.00
