RECREATION COMMITTEE MEETING

June 29, 2005

There was a Recreation Committee meeting held at the Community Centre on Thursday, June 29, 2005. Present were: Recreation Committee Chair Bob Kingsbury; Sub-Chairs: Reeve Robert Johnston, Councillor David Bennett, Sharon Bennett; Natalie Atkins, Recreation Members: Paul Lonergan, Theresa Lonergan, Patti Stewart, Casey Stewart, Barbara Dickson, Ralph Miller, Judy Campbell, Anne Andrechek, Karen Corbin, Chris Maheral, Vic Maheral; and Rose Curley, Secretary.

**1. Call To Order**

Chair Kingsbury called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

**2. Disclosure of Pecuniary Interest**

There was no disclosure of pecuniary interest.

**3. Corkage Fee Charge**

Chair Kingsbury reported that it was brought to his attention that our current rental agreement does not address corkage fees. The rental contract that had been signed for a wedding in July did not indicate any corkage fee charge. Therefore, he is requesting that this fee be waived for this event. Next he is requesting that the committee look at phrasing for instating "corkage fee charges" into our contract and bringing it into effect immediately.

After discussion, Chair Kingsbury asked the committee to vote on whether or not the clients holding a wedding reception at the community centre in July should be charged any corkage fee.

That the Recreation Committee recommends to Council that we rescind the corkage fee for the upcoming event (wedding) in July.

The Committee also discussed and reviewed the phrasing that should be utilized for instating "corkage fee charges" in our current rental contract. Chair Kingsbury then requested the Sub-Chairs to vote on the new wording that would be presented to Council for approval at their next meeting.

That the Recreation Committee recommends to Council that they approve the new wording in the rental agreement that applies to the corkage fee charges and to the charge for the special occasion permit required for allowing the renter to bring in their own wine.

All sub-chairs voted in favour of the new wording.

**4. Bar Assistance Required - July 09 & July 16, 2005**

Chair Kingsbury noted that he requires help for running the bar for two events in July. If he is unable to get sufficient help he will have to look at hiring help for these events. He asked members to let Rose Curley know at the end of the meeting if they are available to help out.

**5. Castleford Women Institute's request**

The Community reviewed a request from the Castleford Women's Institute and everyone agreed that they could utilize the community centre for a meeting in July to organize their annual convention.

**6. Other Business**

- TSSA order

The Committee discussed the work required to meet a TSSA order that was issued last spring. After discussion, the Committee arranged a work bee for August 13, 2005 at 8:00 a.m. to carry out this work

- Chair Lift

Anne Andrechek reported on requirements needed to meet regulations for a chair lift for the upstairs meeting room. The cost to meet these requirements would be in the \$20,000 to \$25,000 range. The Committee agreed to put this on hold and to check on possible funding for this at a later date.
