PUBLIC WORKS REPORT FOR COUNCIL

JUNE 2009

WORK PROJECTS CARRIED OUT IN JUNE

- Cleaned out the bottom of the ditch and fixed the pitrun shoulder on Mullins Road where the surface treatment is going
- Hauled gravel to Mullins Road to put a five to six inch lift of gravel for the surface treatment
- On Wednesday June 3 we picked up our Road Closed barricades from the Millennium Trail and put up snow fence at the bridge that has to be fixed.
- Hauled and spread gravel on Early Road. The heavy trucks crossing the road have busted through the soft spots.
- On June 4 the backhoe worked at the Rink Building – dug a trench around the building to lay down two inch Styrofoam. Truck #2 hauled gravel to the building.
- Dug out and lowered a 400 mm culvert on Eady Road – raised up by frost.
- On June 9 Truck # 2 and Truck # 3 hauled pitrun from Stevenson's pit to the Septage Lot and the backhoe stock piled the pitrun.
- Over the last couple of years we have stockpiling winter sand outside in the yard, so when it rains the yard turns into six inches of mush. We graded up (windrowed) the winter sand and loaded it and hauled to the Landfill Site for use there. Then we hauled in gravel and spread across the yard.
- Hauled gravel to the Jim Barr Road to fix the turnaround.
- June 12 picked up garbage bin from Stone Ridge (Mike Welch) Backhoe and Truck # 3.
- Ditching job on Pucker Street. Cleaned out ditch to laneway culvert and then ditch to crossroad culvert.
- Wednesday June 17 we did our gravel contract on Cobus Road. We had the grader and Truck # 3 as watertruck – put down 4500 tonnes.
- June 17 put the Brush Hog onto the tractor and started cutting along sides of the roads.
- Ditching job on Lochwinnoch Road – clean out bottom of ditch
- Changed culvert on Humphries Road, took the old twelve inch culvert out and installed new sixteen inch culvert. Then hauled pitrun to cover the culvert and fill in dip in the road.
- Installed laneway culvert on Humphries Road where we built the road up with pitrun.
- Hauled gravel to cover the pitrun on Humphries Road.

MISCELLANEOUS JOBS

- Fixed and straightened road name signs and regulatory signs.
- June 3,4,8,17 & 22 we spread flake calcium in front of houses on various roads.
- Cutting grass, lawn maintenance
- Put up nine 911 signs
- Cold patching – big cold patching job in Cotieville and on other paved roads
- Open beaver dam at culvert on the Lime Kiln Road
- Litter pickup along sides of roads
- Plant tree at the Community Centre
- Cutting grass around guard rails
- Cutting along side of roads with Brush Hog
- Had to move barricades off the K&P trail to look for a beaver dam in behind Thompson Trailer Park – water cannot get away from Lime Kiln Road

EQUIPMENT REPAIRS

- Hooked up light plug-in onto Truck # 10 for utility trailer
- Changed clutch plates on Gravel Pro
- Picked up two batteries for the tractor, two for the Garbage truck and one for the Backhoe
- Welding on the main arm on the Brush Hog
- Replaced sliders on the bottom of the Brush Hog
