**SPECIAL PLANNING COMMITTEE**

APRIL 22, 2008

There was a Special Meeting of the Planning Committee held in the Community Centre on Tuesday April 22, 2008 to receive the first draft of the Township's Comprehensive Zoning By-law. Present were Chair Dave Bennett, Mae Craig, Robert A. Johnston, Bob Kingsbury, John Wilson, Bill Winters and staff members Rose Curley and Mackie McLaren.

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Bennett called the meeting to order at 3:15 p.m.

2. DRAFT COMPREHENSIVE ZONING BY-LAW

Charles Cheesman, Planner County of Renfrew, and Judith Jeffrey, Planning Technician County of Renfrew, presented a draft copy of the new Comprehensive Zoning By-law for the Township of Horton. Mr. Cheesman reviewed the By-law outlining the sections of Definitions, of General Provisions and of Zone Classifications.

The Committee discussed several policies in the document which they will take time at future meetings to debate further.

Following the presentation Charles asked the Committee members to review the document and discuss any changes. He will then be back to the Committee to discuss the changes they suggested and to incorporate them into the draft By-law. He pointed out to the Committee Members that once the draft document is in a form that the Committee has accepted there will be twenty days notice for a Public Meeting. When the Public Meeting is held a by-law will be passed following a minimum of seven days from the Public Meeting. The By-law is subject to appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board by ratepayers.
