PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE
August 10, 2006

There was a Meeting of the Public Works Committee held in the Municipal Council Chambers on August 10, 2006. Present were: Chair Dave Bennett, Reeve Robert A. Johnston and Councillor Don Eady, and Rod Eady, Public Works Superintendent.

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Bennett called the Meeting to Order at 8:35 a.m.

2. RESUMES FOR JOB POSTING

The Committee reviewed resumes received for the seasonal part-time position. They determined that three applicants would be interviewed. A Public Works Committee meeting was scheduled for Tuesday, August 15, 2006 at 7:00 p.m. Rod Eady is to contact the applicants and arrange for interviews beginning at 7:15 p.m. Also, at this meeting they will review the 2006 Budget and discuss Goshen and Mullins Roads.

3. GOSHEN ROAD RECONSTRUCTION

Rod Eady informed the Committee that the laser is arriving shortly. This will be used to survey the graph designed by Reeve Johnston. This graph was designed on elevations for ditching on the Goshen Road. The Committee discussed organizing a public meeting for residents on the Goshen Road when all designs have been completed.

Rod Eady was directed to call local contractors and request an estimate for ditching on the Goshen Road. He was also directed to present a new tender for surface treatment on Mullins Road.

4. OTHER BUSINESS

Councillor Don Eady informed the Committee that a commercial weigh scale has been installed at Jamieson's Pit on Whitton Road. His concern was that all the heavy loads would have a detrimental effect on the new surface on Whitton Road. Rod Eady was directed to investigate this.

Rod Eady informed the Committee that due to the resignation of Horton's Safety Representative a new one will be chosen by the employees of the Public Works Department when they return from their holidays (approximately 2 weeks).
