GOSHEN ROAD RECONSTRUCTION

SEPTEMBER 05, 2006

7:30 P.M.

1. CALL TO ORDER

Reeve Johnston called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

2. DECLARATION OF PECUNIARY INTEREST

There was no declaration of pecuniary interest by members of Council.

3. PROPOSED ELEVATIONS/CROSS SECTION OF DITCHES

Reeve gave a detailed explanation of the construction of the road to the members of the Public present using charts showing the elevations and cross section of ditches which he and the Road Superintendent had prepared.

4. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

There were seven members of the Public present who asked some questions. They wondered why it had taken so long to do this work, would it be finished in 2006 or would it become an election issue - Council assured them it was not an election issue. A grant of \$109,000 has been received which is being used for the Goshen Road. The ditching, installation of culverts, spreading of soil and planting of grass seed will be done this year and the surface treatment will be reassessed and completed next year.

Members of the Public present emphasized that they want a good job done, with the ditches only dug out and culverts placed where necessary.

5. COUNCIL MEMBERS COMMENTS

Councilor Eady commented that the Township has purchased a debermer and will have a tractor to run it next year to cut back the vegetation and keep it down. He also informed the members of the public that B. R. Fulton has been awarded the contract to do the ditching work in front of their houses on Goshen Road.
