

COMMUNITY POLICING ADVISORY COMMITTEE
TOWNSHIP OF MCNAB/BRAESIDE COUNCIL CHAMBERS

SEPTEMBER 17, 2012 - 7:30 P.M.

There was a meeting of the Community Policing Advisory Committee held in the Township of McNab/Braeside Council Chambers on Monday September 17th, 2012. Present were Chair Brad McIlquham from McNab/Braeside, Glen Campbell from Horton, Allen Dick from White Water Region, Glenda McKay from Greater Madawaska and Bobby Campbell from McNab/Braeside. Also present was OPP Staff Sergeant Colin Slight and Committee Secretary Christina Mulcahey.

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Brad McIlquham called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

2. MINUTES OF LAST MEETING

The Committee reviewed the minutes from the July 16th 2012 Committee meeting.

3. BUSINESS ARISING FROM MINUTES

Glenda McKay asked Staff Sgt. Slight to resend the non-emergency phone number banner that was published in the local phone books.

Bobby Campbell from McNab/Braeside asked if Staff Sgt. Slight had an opportunity to look into why the Officer did not check inside the building at Gillies Landing to see that the youth were still in the building. Staff Sgt. Slight said he did not have a chance to look into the call but he will.

4. COMMUNITY POLICING REPORT & SPEEDBOARD REPORT

Staff Sgt. Slight handed out the reports to each member of the Committee and briefly reviewed the reports. There was also a new report that he handed out showing the amount of hours in the specific Township.

Staff Sgt. Slight said to let him know if there were any concerns.

5. COMMITTEE INPUT

Chair McIlquham requested that Janice Sawbridge attend one of our Committee Meetings. Staff Sgt. Slight said he would mention that to her.

Glenda McKay said that there are ATV's travelling through the village in Greater Madawaska and there are 2 people riding on the bikes. She asked for patrols to keep an eye out for the ATV's in the area.

Allen Dick reported that Whitewater Region had their bass tournament and everything went well. There were 40 boats or more in attendance.

Glen Campbell reported that on Horton Public School Road there are still issues with the stop sign and vehicles not paying attention to it. He asked for patrols on Pinnacle Road and Cotieville Road. He noted that the Highway will be reduced to one lane coming up again soon and he asked for patrols on Goshen Road which becomes the short cut.

Bobby Campbell from McNab/Braeside asked about the Safety Zone in Sand Point and asked if it was worthwhile. Staff Sgt. Slight said yes he believes so.

He also mentioned the issue with the garbage all over the road on the days the Landfill Site is open in Braeside. Brad McIlquham said they may have money set aside in the budget to have the OPP do some patrols for a certain amount of paid hours while the Landfill site is open.

Bobby also noted about the speeding on Campbell Drive. He saw children waiting for the bus and cannot believe how quick the people travelling by are going. Staff Sgt. Slight said that parents also need to remind their children to not wait close to the road.
