Special Waste Management Committee Meeting

February 01, 2013

There was a Special Meeting of the Waste Management Committee held in the Municipal Council Chambers on Friday, February 01, 2013. Present was Chair Jamey Larone, Acting Mayor/Councillor Bob Kingsbury and Committee Member John Wilson. Staff present: Rose Curley, Administrative Assistant and Mackie McLaren, CAO/Clerk.

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Larone called the meeting to order at 10:30 a.m.

2. DECLARATION OF PECUNIARY INTEREST

There was no declaration of pecuniary interest by committee members or staff.

3. JOSEPH HALL – REDI RECYCLING INC. - LANDFILL SITE MANAGEMENT PROPOSAL

- **Review service proposal**

Joe Hall, Redi Recycling Inc. was present to review and discuss a service proposal he had submitted to the Committee in 2012. Mr. Hall said that he is putting together a proposal and materials regarding the process and benefits of several local municipalities joining together to create a local Waste Management Board. There are great benefits to this including cost savings in joint projects. Waste Diversion Ontario looks favourable on these joint undertakings and this could result in extra Blue Box Funding through the Datacall reporting. He has been talking to Mike Berett from the Continuous Improvement Fund (CIF) and there is money available (50 percent of costs) for these types of projects.

After discussion, the Committee agreed that Horton Township would host a meeting, possibly in April, to explore this option with other municipalities, once Mr. Hall has completed his research/proposal. Further, Mike Berett, CIF would be invited to the meeting for his input and review on forming a local board. Mr. Hall was requested to let Mackie McLaren, CAO/Clerk know once he has completed his work on this project. The Committee also reviewed the other highlights of his service proposal and asked Mr. Hall if the Committee could defer a decision on this until Mayor Eady is back from his leave, hopefully in March. Mr. Hall said that this was fine with him.

4. E-WASTE PICKUP ISSUES

Mackie McLaren, CAO/Clerk reviewed the recent issues we have encountered lately with E-Waste pickup by Ontario Electronic Stewardship (OES).

Mr. Joe Hall, Redi Recycling Inc. offers a similar e-waste pickup service and was asked to give an overview of this service. Mr. Hall said that he is an approved transporter/packer with OES. If he was selected, the Township would contact him when a pickup was needed and he would do all the required phone calls and paperwork. He would also pay the Township \$200/tonne for the E-waste. The Committee noted that a resident who contacted them with a similar offer will be reviewing his

proposal at the Waste Management Committee meeting on March 21, 2013. The Committee will wait until after that meeting to make a recommendation to Council.

5. OTHER BUSINESS

There was no other business.
