

COMMUNITY POLICING ADVISORY COMMITTEE
TOWNSHIP OF WHITEWATER REGION COUNCIL CHAMBERS

JANUARY 21, 2013 - 7:00 P.M.

There was a meeting of the Community Policing Advisory Committee held in the Township of White Water Region Chambers on Monday January 21st 2013. Present were Chair Brad McIlquham from McNab/Braeside, Glen Campbell from Horton, Allen Dick from White Water Region, and Aldene Styles from McNab/Braeside. Also present was OPP Staff Sergeant Colin Slight and Committee Secretary Christina Mulcahey. Absent was Glenda McKay from Greater Madawaska.

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Brad McIlquham called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m.

Chair McIlquham informed the Committee that Aldene Styles is replacing Bobby Campbell as McNab/Braeside Committee member.

2. MINUTES OF LAST MEETING

The Committee reviewed the minutes from the November 19th 2012 Committee meeting.

3. BUSINESS ARISING FROM MINUTES

4. COMMUNITY POLICING REPORT

Staff Sergeant Slight handed out the reports to each Committee Member. He explained that the server was down and therefore did not have as detailed reports as usual. The Committee reviewed.

Staff Sergeant Slight referred to the 4 year Business Plan and noted we are now in year 3. He asked the Committee members if each municipality is still satisfied with the four main goals that are outlined. Committee members agreed yes.

Staff Sergeant Slight informed the Committee that the Speedboard does not get used very often during the winter months. He said he did email the Committee members the speedboard report that was requested at the last meeting.

Staff Sergeant Slight noted that they are Regionally looking at purchasing new electronic speed boards that are put up for multiple weeks at a time. They are an expensive device.

6. COMMITTEE INPUT

Allen Dick from White Water Region said all was fairly quiet. He did mention that their annual Fishing Derby is coming up next month.

Aldene Styles from McNab/Braeside said she has nothing to add at this time.

Glen Campbell from Horton Township said he had a call from a resident on Ferguson Road concerning snowmobiles that were travelling at a high speed as they were very concerned.

Glen Campbell also asked Staff Sergeant Slight to have an Officer attend the next Public Works Committee Meeting to be held on February 20th at 8:30 a.m. The Committee is looking at lowering speed limits on Township roads and would like to discuss the proposal with an OPP Officer and have their input.

Chair McIlquham asked Staff Sergeant Slight if there are any savings now that the Town of Arnprior Police has joined together with Renfrew. Staff Sergeant Slight said there will be some savings and he will let the Committee know what the savings are.

7. APPROVE INVOICE

That the Committee approves Invoice No. 166-12 to cover the cost of Secretarial Duties for the year of 2012 in the amount of \$418.88.
