

COMMUNITY POLICING ADVISORY COMMITTEE
TOWNSHIP OF GREATER MADAWASKA COUNCIL CHAMBERS

APRIL 22 2013 - 7:30 P.M.

There was a meeting of the Community Policing Advisory Committee held in the Township of Greater Madawaska Council Chambers on Monday April 22nd 2013. Present were Chair Brad McIlquham from McNab/Braeside, Glen Campbell from Horton, Allen Dick from White Water Region, Aldene Styles from McNab/Braeside and Glenda McKay and Bruno Kierczak from Greater Madawaska. Also present was OPP Staff Sergeant Colin Slight, Nicholas Decock, Research Analyst for the Ontario Provincial Police and Committee Secretary Christina Mulcahey.

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Brad McIlquham called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Glenda McKay informed the Committee that Bruno will be in attendance this evening as their Council may be switching Committee members.

2. MINUTES OF LAST MEETING

The Committee reviewed the minutes from the January 21st 2013 Committee meeting.

3. BUSINESS ARISING FROM MINUTES

4. COMMUNITY POLICING REPORT

Staff Sergeant Slight reviewed the Policing Reports with Committee members. He noted that they just finished up the "Safe Winter Driving" campaign and will begin "Speeding Costs you Deerly" Campaign soon.

Staff Sergeant Slight introduced Nicholas Decock at this time. Nicholas Decock, Research Analyst for the Ontario Provincial Police was present to discuss with the Committee a survey being conducted. This survey will gather information to identify any recommended changes to the Police Services Act regarding civilian governance of OPP municipal policing to align with potential revisions to the OPP billing structure. There was discussion on the questions presented in the survey.

5. SPEEDBOARD REPORT

Staff Sergeant Slight gave a brief update on the speedboard and said there was some maintenance done to it. He noted that Constable Darren Chaplin is in charge of the speedboard now. There was no actual report to review at this time.

6. COMMITTEE INPUT

Brad McIlquham informed Staff Sergeant Slight that the Township of McNab/Braeside is interested in paid policing for an upcoming Saturday morning when the Landfill Site is open. Staff Sergeant Slight will contact the CAO.

Brad McIlquham asked Staff Sergeant Slight if there was any report on the Safety Zone on River Road in Braeside such as tickets being issued. Staff Sergeant Slight said he could do some searches on the area.

Glen Campbell asked if there were any leads on the Community Center damages in Horton Township. Apparently there were multiple Community Centers in the area that had damage done. Staff Sergeant Slight said he could research as he wasn't aware of any. Glen Campbell also noted that Price Road in Horton Township will be active again with Spring coming and patrols on this road for dumping garbage would be appreciated. This road has always had issues with people dumping garbage.
