

COMMUNITY POLICING ADVISORY COMMITTEE

MARCH 31ST - 7:30 P.M.

There was a meeting of the Community Policing Advisory Committee held in the Township of McNab/Braeside Council Chambers on Monday March 31st 2014. Present were Chair Brad McIlquham from McNab/Braeside, Aldene Styles from McNab/Braeside and Glenda McKay from Greater Madawaska. Also present was OPP Officer Janice Sawbridge and Committee Secretary Christina Mulcahey. Absent were Glen Campbell from Horton and Allen Dick from White Water Region and Inspector Colin Slight.

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chair McIlquham called the meeting to order at 7:40 p.m.

2. MINUTES OF LAST MEETING

The Committee reviewed the minutes from the December 16th 2013 Committee meeting.
