3. BUSINESS ARISING FROM MINUTES

Inspector Slight informed Mr. McIlquham that a follow up email had been sent to the investigating Officer regarding the accident on Highway 17 and Campbell Drive. Inspector Slight will look back into his email history.

#### 4. COMMUNITY POLICING REPORT

Inspector Slight handed out the Policing Report. This is a new formatted report with year to date columns. This gives a view of where the stats are as of today compared to the previous year. He reviewed the reports with the Committee. Glenda McKay noted that the graphs showing to the side don't seem to be accurate.

Inspector Slight then made a power point presentation on Crime Prevention in Ontario. Public Safety is very important. Crime Rates are decreasing and Policing Costs are increasing. There were many slides that he discussed.

One slide was "How to increase Community Safety and Reduce Calls for Service"

- 1) Asses the Situation
- 2) Make a Plan
- 3) Put it into Action

Glenda McKay asked Inspector Slight when Greater Madawaska can expect answer to a letter that was sent to him. He replied by the end of the week.

Glen Campbell noted there were some thefts from vehicles during the last few weeks in Horton. Inspector Slight referred back to the "Lock it or Lose it" campaign that is on. It is very important to try and educate the public with this campaign. He noted that other Municipalities have sent out this information in Newsletters or etc.

Brad McIlquham noted the July 1<sup>st</sup> Parade in Braeside and asked if there would be Auxiliary available to attend.

Allen Dick requested the Speedboard be used on the long weekend in August on Grant Settlement Road as the weekend will be busy with rafting.

5. A) NEW POLICING PRICING MODEL

Brad McIlquham noted that McNab will be looking at paying over a million dollars with the new formula. He stated that this is not affordable. Inspector Slight said he does not have the final formula as it has not been released yet but the reality is yes, the cost will be going up.

There was more discussion of the new pricing formula.

Chair McIlquham suggested we continue discussion at the next meeting.
