1. CALL TO ORDER

Councillor Larone inquired about the day noted in the minutes as well as the value of the replacement costs for the two furnaces, was the \$10,000 for each or in total. Councillor Kingsbury noted in total. Minutes were amended accordingly.

Councillor Kingsbury noted that the Treasurer will report on HST implications for catering services at the next Recreation meeting. Also, the Treasurer will update her records regarding Recreation Reserve balances.

THAT Horton Township Council authorizes the Administrative Assistant to submit an application under the Enabling Accessibility Fund Program (EAF), to fund a stair lift for the stage at the Horton Community Centre, by the August 01, 2014 submission deadline.

FURTHER THAT, the Township's share of \$9,000 for project costs be funded from the Accessibility Fund - \$5,000 and the Hall Expansion Fund - \$4,000.00. These monies will satisfy the eligibility requirement under the Enabling Accessibility Fund Program that 35 percent of project funding (inkind and monetary) be provided from non-Federal government sources.

5. PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE (Action from July 23, 2014 Committee Meeting)

THAT Council on recommendation of the Public Works Committee adopts a policy eliminating Private Road grading, commencing July 23, 2014, free or otherwise, due to liability, staffing, equipment and road condition concerns; and

Councillor Larone likes the idea of a subcommittee of the Public Works Committee being set up to further research private road grading and bring recommendations back in the future.

Resolution No. 2014-241

THAT the Council of the Township of Horton accept the Business Plan for the improvements to the CN Trail, and agrees to commence the program with the application of donated stone dust.

Work is to commence in early August 2014 and will proceed until the commitments on hand, totalling \$6,500 has been used.

In addition, further work can proceed once additional funding commitments have been received.

Finally, Council agrees that they will carry the funding commitments if the commitments are over several years until the commitments have been received.

Discussion

Councillor Larone inquired about the Recreation Committee use of the trail. Councillor Kingsbury stated that this item has not been discussed at the committee but will be added to the next agenda. Mayor Eady noted that Public Works is responsible for the maintenance of the trail and once complete the trail will be open for all in the community to use. Rules and policy will need to be put in place. Mayor Eady thanked Councillor Campbell and staff for the work put into the business plan.

Councillor Whyte noted that this is not an admission of wrong doing on the part of the Township. Councillor Larone agreed that pictures do not always tell the whole story. Mayor Eady noted that this is another example of the grader being too large for many of the private roads.
