

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HORTON

**By-law 2015-43**

Being a By-law to provide for the naming and renaming of the highways, streets, roads and private roads within the Township of Horton

WHEREAS Section 48,61(1) and (2) of the Municipal Act 2001 S.O., 2001, c.25 as amended, authorizes the Councils of local municipalities to pass By-laws giving names to or changing the names of highways, streets, roads and private roads and for affixing the names at the corners thereof, on public or private property;

AND WHEREAS Section 48 of the Municipal Act 2001 S.O., 2001, c. 25 as amended, provides that before a By-law is passed to change the name of a highway, street, road or private road, a municipality shall give Public Notice of its intention to pass the By-law;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Horton has caused a notice of the proposed By-law to be published in the local newspaper on September 9<sup>th</sup> 2015 and at a meeting held on October 6<sup>th</sup>, 2015, has heard any person who claims to be adversely affected by the By-law.

NOW THEREFORE the Council or the Corporation of the Township of Horton HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

**Short Title**

1. This By-law may be cited as the "Road Naming By-law" of the Corporation of the Township of Horton.

**Naming of Highways, Streets, Roads and Private Roads**

2. All highways, streets, roads and private roads in the municipality shall be named and/or known according to Schedule "A" attached to this By-law and as illustrated on Map 1, Map 2, Map 3, Map 4, Map 5, Map 6 and Map 7 attached hereto.
3. Schedule "A" and Maps 1 through Map 7 attached hereto, form part of this By-law.
4. The municipality is hereby authorized to affix street name signs at the corner of every highway, street, road and private road, on public and private property, subject to the jurisdictions and the requirements of the County of Renfrew or the Ministry of Transportation.
5. All road name signs at intersections shall include the approved road name. Where new signs are to be erected, the sign shall include the approved road name and the direction and sequencing of property numbering.
6. Should any section, clause or provision of this By-law hold to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this By-law will not be affected.
7. Any By-laws or parts of By-laws inconsistent with this By-law, or names of streets in registered plans inconsistent with this By-law, are hereby deemed to be repealed.
8. This By-law shall come into force and effect on the date of passing.
