

COMMUNITY POLICING ADVISORY COMMITTEE

APRIL 13TH, 2015

There was a meeting of the Community Policing Advisory Committee held in the Township of Horton Council Chambers on Monday April 13th 2015. Present were Hal Johnson from Whitewater Region, Tom Peckett from McNab/Braeside, Jamey Larone from Horton, Glen MacPherson from Greater Madawaska, Inspector Colin Slight from the Renfrew OPP Detachment and Acting Committee Secretary Jennifer Barr.

1. CALL TO ORDER

Jamey Larone called the meeting to order at 7:35 p.m.

Moved by Hal Johnson, Seconded by Tom Peckett

That the Committee nominates Jamey Larone from Horton Township as the Committee Chair.

4. MINUTES OF LAST MEETING

The Committee members reviewed the minutes from the January 19th 2015 Committee meeting.

5. BUSINESS ARISING FROM MINUTES

Tom Peckett mentioned the speedboard and said he is not convinced it is a necessary item based on Inspector Slight's previous comments. Inspector Slight said it does have its place and time such as construction or festivals. Hal Johnson asked if it counts traffic. Inspector Slight said yes. Hal suggested maybe this would be a better use of the speedboard. Jamey Larone asked what past schedule was followed for the use of it. Inspector Slight said it was typically left for members to deploy and based on requests from township officials. There was no set schedule. Glen MacPherson noted that Greater Madawaska sees events and festivals as the best time to use it. Chair Larone suggested taking information back to Public Works Committees to see if there is a need for the speedboard.

Tom Peckett reported that McNab/Braeside is still having discussions about this Committee and continuing to take part in it. Inspector Slight said that this is a Committee that the four municipalities involved can take control of and take it where they want it to go. The municipalities can set and identify priorities for Community Safety. Chair Larone said public awareness is one goal.

6. COMMUNITY POLICING REPORT

Inspector Slight handed out a statics report for the individual municipalities. He reported there are no major issues to report on.

7. COMMITTEE INPUT

Crime Stoppers – Chair Larone asked what is the status of Crime Stoppers. Inspector Slight said it is still active for the County. Chair Larone asked if we could have a representative come to one of our committee meetings. Inspector Slight said he would be happy to set that up.

8. 2015 COMMITTEE FEES & ACCOUNT BALANCE

Jennifer Barr reported the account balance of \$2125.92 as of March 31st 2015. Inspector Slight said some of these funds could be used for radio ads or newspaper ads for public awareness.

Moved by Tom Peckett, Seconded by Glen MacPherson

That the Committee appoints Jamey Larone as signing officer for the Committee account.
