

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HORTON

BY-LAW NO. 2017-26

**Being a By-Law to Adopt a Beaver Control Policy  
for the Corporation of the Township of Horton**

**WHEREAS** Section 8(1) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, as amended, states that the powers of a Township under this or any other Act shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on a Township to enable it to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the Township's ability to respond to municipal issues;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 11(2) 2 of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, as amended, states that a lower-tier Township may pass by-laws, respecting accountability and transparency of the Township and its operations and of its local boards and their operations;

**AND WHEREAS** Council of the Township of Horton has recognized a Beaver Control Policy is required to assist in flooding prevention within the municipality

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Horton hereby enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** the Beaver Control Policy, attached as Schedule A and Schedule B to this by-law is hereby adopted as an official policy document of the Corporation of the Township of Horton
2. **THAT** Schedule A and Schedule B attached hereto shall be read with and form part of this by-law.
3. **THAT** this by-law may be referred to as the "Beaver Control Policy"
4. **THAT** this By-Law will come into force and effect upon the date of passing.

Read a Third Time and finally passed this 18<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2017
