

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HORTON**

**BY-LAW NUMBER 2017-74**

**BEING A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH THE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR THE  
VOTE-BY-MAIL METHOD FOR THE 2018 MUNICIPAL ELECTION**

**WHEREAS** Section 42 on the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* provides that a municipal council may pass a by-law authorizing an alternative voting method;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Horton passed By-Law 2017-25 authorizing the Vote-By-Mail method for the 2018 Municipal Election;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 42 (3) and (4) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* provides that the Township of Horton must establish the procedures for the Vote-By-Mail method;

**THEREFORE**, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Horton enacts as follows:

1. The Clerk's procedures and rules for the Municipal Election, authorized by Section 42 of the *Municipal Elections Act R.S.O. 1996*, are annexed hereto as Appendix "A", but in accordance with the *Municipal Elections Act R.S.O. 1996* as amended, the Clerk may vary the procedures from time to time as appropriate.
2. Any person, corporation or trade union guilty of corrupt practices or contravening the provisions of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, or the procedures and rules as established in paragraph 1 of this By-law may be prosecuted pursuant to the provisions of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*.

READ a third time and passed this 19<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2017.
