WINTER PARKING BAN AND PROHIBIT PLACING SNOW ON ROADWAYS

Effective immediately, any vehicles parked on roads or streets in Horton Township so as to prohibit or interfere with snowplowing operations shall be towed away at owner's expense, as per Township of Horton By-law 2001-08.

By-law 2001-08 also prohibits the placing or depositing of snow on Township streets or roads. By-law 2001-08 states:

"Any owner or operator found to be in contravention of this by-law is guilty of an offence under the Provincial Offences Act and is liable to a fine of not less than \$100.00 and not more than \$500.00 for each violation thereof."

IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL PROPERTY OWNERS

Property Tax Rebates for

Vacant Commercial and Industrial Buildings

In accordance with Ontario Reg. 325/01, and the Ontario

Municipal Act, 2001, property tax relief for vacant

commercial and industrial buildings in the Township of

Horton will be provided to property owners through rebates

that are issued by the municipality.

To be eligible for a rebate, a building or portion of a building must be unused for at least 90 consecutive days.

It is the property owner's responsibility to ensure the application meets regulatory standards.

For the 2015 tax year, the deadline to submit applications is February 29, 2016.

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
