NEW BURNING RESTRICTIONS

Council has passed a new burning by-law. This by-law changes when and where open air fires (bonfires) and burn barrels are permitted. The changes include:

- No bonfires permitted anywhere in the Township during the
 April 1 to October 31 Fire Season
- Bonfires will <u>only</u> be permitted in the rural areas **after** the Fire Season (November 1 to March 31) with a permit application and approval
- Fire Department will issue all fire permits 10 day's notice required before permit is issued
- Burn barrels are not permitted in the residential areas anytime of the year
- Burn barrels are permitted in the rural areas after the Fire Season, providing the barrel is located more than 100 metres from your lot line and a permit is issued
- Campfires are permitted during Fire Season without a permit providing the fire pit meets the minimum specifications set out in the by-law.
- Grass fires and burning leaves are not permitted at any time of the year.
- The Fire Chief has the right to revoke or cancel any Open Air Burning, including Campfires at any time.

The Residential areas include the hamlets of Cotieville, Thompsonville, Mobile Home Parks, all waterfront areas and in all other built up areas, example Jamieson Lane, sections of Gillan Road, Lochwinnoch Road between Hwy 17 and Goshen Road and sections of Pinnacle Road.
