SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING

FEBRUARY 19, 2008

There was a Special Meeting of Council held in the Municipal Council Chambers on Tuesday February 19, 2008. All members of Council were present with the exception of Councillors Eady and Kingsbury.

1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Johnston called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

2. DECLARATION OF PECUNIARY INTEREST

Councillor Bennett declared pecuniary interest in No.4 Emergency Generator Quotes.

3. EMERGENCY PLANNING – JIM FERGUSON

Our Community Emergency Planning Coordinator was present. He informed Council of the following:

a. <u>Letter of Compliance from the Minister of Community, Safety & Correctional</u> Services

Mr. Ferguson presented a copy of a letter dated February 12, 2008 from the Ministry which confirmed that the Township has fulfilled the municipal requirement for 2007, under the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act.

Council thanked Jim and his group of volunteers for work he has provided, acknowledging that this compliance is a direct result of the Committee's service.

b. County Wide Pandemic Exercise for 2008

Jim Ferguson presented information from the Emergency Services Department of the County of Renfrew. They received a JEPP funding grant for a County Wide Pandemic Emergency Exercise in 2008 and asked if the Township would participate with them, at no cost.

That the Township of Horton agrees to participate in the County of Renfrew's 2008 County Wide Pandemic Emergency Exercise.

c. <u>Horton Emergency Exhibition October 2008</u>

Mr. Ferguson informed Council that the Emergency Committee is organizing a second annual Emergency Exhibition at the Horton Community Centre for October 2008.

d. Emergency Week – 72 Hour Emergency Kits

Mr. Ferguson reported Emergency Week is coming up in May, and the Committee with leadership from Andy Tait, the alternate CEMC, will be providing each household with our requirements for a 72 hour emergency kit.

e. Weekender Insert – 72 Hour Emergency Kits

Jim Ferguson also reported that during that time the Renfrew Weekender will have a section on emergency kits, that his Committee will prepare.

Council thanked Jim Ferguson for attending and for keeping them up to date.

4. EMERGENCY GENERATOR QUOTATIONS

Councillor Bennett declared pecuniary interest and did not take part in the discussion or decision.
