C. Graham and M. McLaren explained the role and objectives of the joint recycling committee is to establish a multi-recycling strategy plan to be submitted to the Province by mid 2011.

Invitations were mailed to interested parties to provide a quote for a joint recycling strategy for the Joint Committee. The Guidelines and recycling template are available on the WDO web site for review and are designed specifically to meet provincial expectations for a community specific waste recycling plan. WDO has already approved the joint recycling plan up to \$ 45,000.00.

Six quotations were received in accordance with the specified date and time.
