On December 21st, 2020 Premier Doug Ford announced a Provincial Lockdown beginning 12:01 a.m. Saturday, December 26th, 2020. Horton residents are encouraged to follow the guidelines and protocols of our local experts in Public Health. The Township is taking further actions to help protect the health of our community and prevent the spread of the virus.

- Residents are encouraged to make property tax payments online or use the drop box at the Office;

- All Garbage and Recycling CURBSIDE pick-up will remain the same. Please check the calendar to ensure pick-up dates during the holidays;
- The Landfill will remain open during its regular hours, at this time;
- Burn permits can continue to be applied for online at <u>www.hortontownship.ca</u>;
- The Community Centre is closed for rentals;
- Council will continue to meet virtually to ensure continuity.
