## Private Road Maintenance

Residents on private roads are encouraged to trim and maintain trees, shrubs, bushes, etc. to ensure emergency vehicles can access properties. Private roads should be cleared to a minimum of 100 inches wide and 112 inches tall for optimal response time.



# Pay Your Taxes Online

Residents are encouraged to make their Tax Payment via their online or telephone banking.

1. Open banking app or banking website and login.
2. Go to pay bills.
3. Click add payee and search "Horton" (Horton Township Taxes should appear).
4. For account number, add roll number of property.

**\*\*If you have multiple properties, each roll number must be added, and amount paid to each roll number\*\***

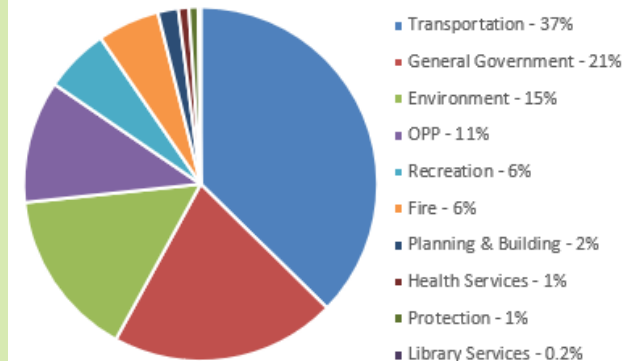
# 2023 Tax Rates

In March, Council was presented a draft budget resulting in a 5.44% increase. Discussion ensued and Staff was directed to present a final budget of 2.5%. The final budget was amended and presented at the Public Meeting on April 18, 2023, with a levy of \$2,682,003.
